## WYO LEG TAKES LEAD IN MANAGING MAGICHITE CRAZE

Cheyenne - Wyoming legislators have taken steps to bring order to the "magichite rush," which the majority of its members believes to be threatening the state's economic, cultural and environmental balance. The establishment of and appointment of members to a Magichite Development Task Force will occur after the end of this year's legislative session. The Task Force will be responsible for designing and overseeing the implementation of a plan to insure the responsible development of magichite resources.

Senator Chase A. Dream, voting against the bill sponsored by Senator B. Careful from Jackson Hole complained, "Right ... just what we need is another task force. By the time we decide how to do it, someone else will discover magichite deposits exceeding our own somewhere else. Wyoming will bust before it ever booms."

Acknowledging that the state is no stranger to energy and mineral development, proponents of the action hope to bring together industry officials and citizens to apply what's been learned in the past from the development of other resources. The goal is to find a balanced approach to the exploration, mining, processing and production of magichite and its amazing products.
